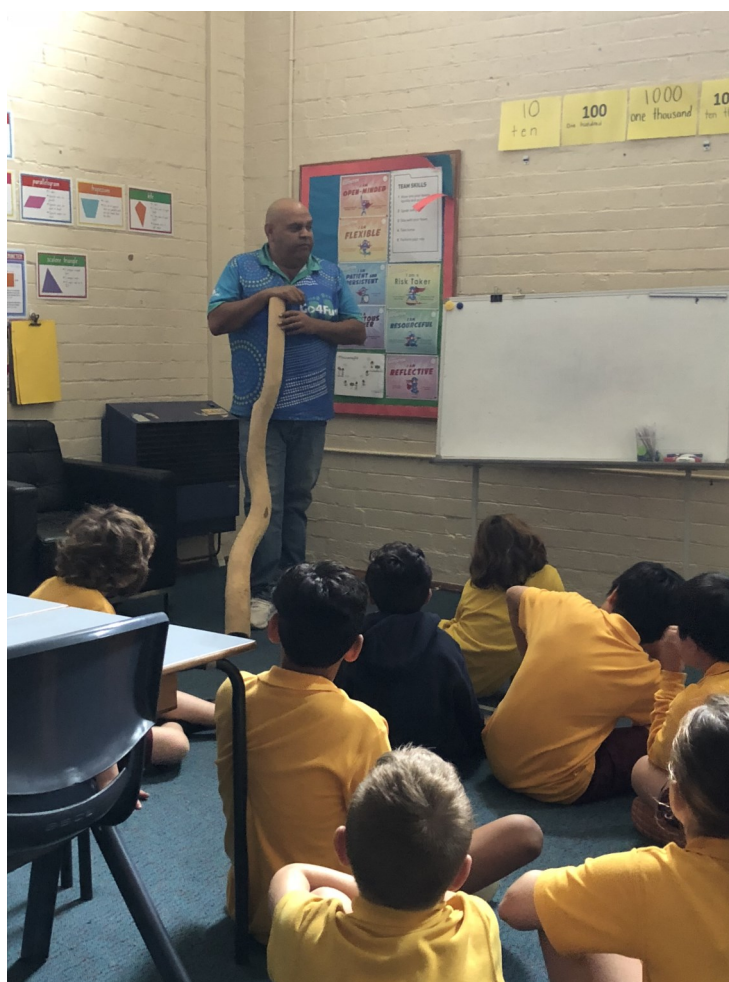

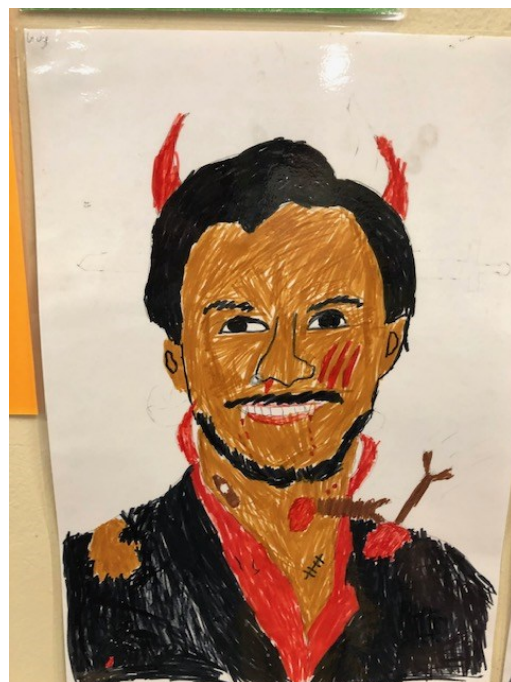

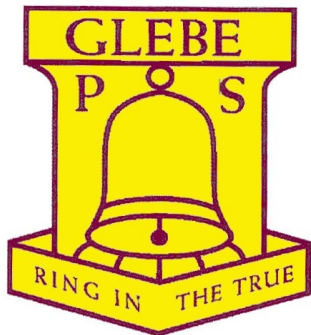
End of year get-together

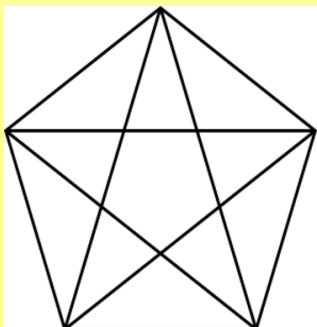

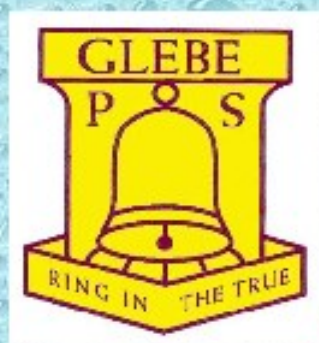

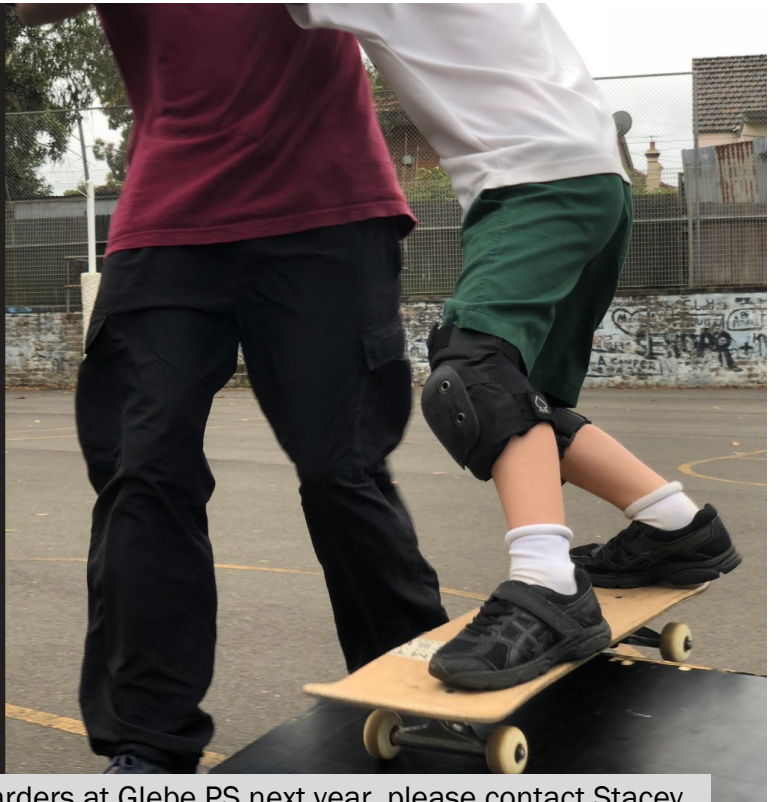
