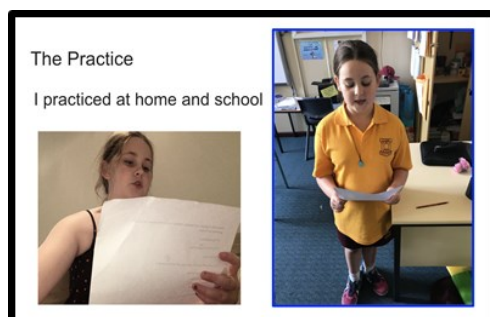

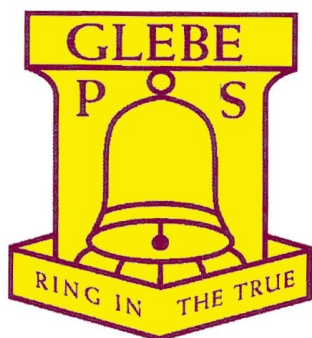
**Saturday, 15 Dec.** - Christmas Cake Stall
