

Speech <u>Pathology</u> <u>Enquiry</u> Sessions

Students from The University of Sydney will be available to answer any questions or enquiries about both typical communication and communication challenges on three Thursdays at the beginning of Term 4. Parents are welcome to approach the table set up under the cola with questions to discuss their child or to enquire about a referral to the SPEECH Clinic across the road.

What is The University of Sydney SPEECH Clinic?

The University of Sydney SPEECH Clinic (Speech Pathology Evidence-based Education in Communication, Swallowing and Hearing Clinic) aims to provide optimal services to clients (both adult and children) who have trouble communicating or swallowing.

Therapy runs all year for blocks of 6-12 weeks, in both in person and telehealth format. Costs are minimal and sessions are run by student speech pathologists under the supervision of fully qualified speech pathologists.







